

- Solid ground rules, but informal style
- Specific structure for decisions

- Issues are not avoided, but addressed in a non-threatening way
- Everyone is allowed to state both public positions and private thoughts
- Identifying political and policy tradeoffs early in the process

Ground Rules

- Everyone's voice counts
 - Take turns
 - Each perspective is valid
 - Listen respectfully
 - Questions are okay
- Forward movement
- Positive Recommendations



Responsibilities

- Participate (no alternatives)
- Positive
- Perspective
- Acknowledge conflicts of interest
- Leverage resources
- Advocate
- Knowledge
- Share information



Working Consensus

- Everyone gets their say
- Recommendations you can "live with"
- If we must vote: 80% = consensus (in attendance)
